



Carbondale & Rural Fire Protection District COVID-19 Building Cleaning Guidelines

Purpose & General Information

The purpose of this document is to provide guidelines for cleaning of all fire stations and administrative buildings.

General Cleaning Principles – All Stations

- If surfaces are dirty, they should be cleaned using detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection.
- For disinfection use bleach wipes, Caviwipes 1, or bleach in a concentration of 1/3rd cup bleach per gallon of water or 4 teaspoons bleach per quart of water.
- Wear disposable gloves for all tasks in the cleaning process, including handling trash.
- Additional PPE should be used where there is a risk of splash.
- Gloves (and gowns) should be removed carefully to avoid contamination of the wearer and the surrounding area.
- Wash hands immediately after gloves are removed. Wash with soap and water for 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available and hands are not visibly dirty, an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains 60%-95% alcohol may be used.

Cleaning & Disinfecting Station 81

- Perform cleaning and disinfection at least once a day.
- Perform cleaning and disinfection immediately after shift change and before apparatus checks.
- When an unauthorized individual enters operations please have them leave then immediately perform cleaning and disinfection of any area or surface they came in contact with.

Cleaning of Administrative Building

- The Administrative building should be cleaned and disinfected at least once a day. Disinfect all frequently touched surfaces, such as workstations, countertops, doorknobs, printers, coffee pots, telephones, toilets, etc...
- Each individual should clean and disinfect

Cleaning Outlying Stations

- Cleaning and disinfection as needed post run or weekly
