Response is prepared for crisis response and we are working diligently to make sure we can continue to provide a full spectrum of services, including support and safety planning, while following best practices and recommended protocols from health organizations.

We want to assure survivors of assault and abuse that immediate assistance remains available during COVID-19 related closures.
