Team Guidelines:

- 1) Entry Fee for a Team of five or less will be \$125.00 (one hundred twenty five dollars), with all proceeds going to Special Olympics Colorado.
Early registrants will be given priority for their time of "team pull" (see above to choose time).
- 2) Teams may consist of 5-10 members....you decide. There will be an added cost of \$20.00 for each additional member above the basic five team members to a possible total of \$225.00 for a ten person team.
- 3) Entry Forms may be completed on site and will be accepted on a "first come first served" basis until all time slots have been filled.
- 4) The total number of entries may be limited on site, at the discretion of the event coordinator, after considering the allowed time constraints of the event.
- 5) No "on site" entries will be accepted after 1:00 PM.
- 6) All Participants will be required to sign a "Waiver and Medical Release". If the participant is a minor or might be considered to be unable to understand the "Waiver and Medical Release", said "Release" will need to be signed by a parent, guardian or a person representing that they have the right to sign for said participant.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1) Every Team Member will receive a commemorative tee shirt announcing ***"I pulled the BearCat"***
- 2) Each member will weigh in at the site with the total team weight being used as one factor to determine the winning team. That team will receive the traveling trophy and bragging rights for one year!
- 3) The course is the same for all teams, with the lowest product of team weight and time used to determine the winning team!
 - a. This product is expressed as (weight X time) or in (pound-seconds)
- 4) Up to two Special Olympians can be on a team, their weight will ***NOT*** be added to the total team weight; nor will there be an added assessment to the team for participation by a Special Olympian.
We encourage every team to meet a special Olympian and recruit them for your team pull.
- 5) You may be a member of more than one team if you choose
- 6) Two timers will record start and stop of every "Pull" with the time recorded being the average of those two times
- 7) Now Let the Fun Begin!!!
