NON -REFUNDABLE FEE for Appliances and TV's These fees apply to all appliance and TV donations.

Appliances:

• A \$20 non-refundable fee is required on donation of appliances

TV's:

- 18" and larger, a \$40 non-refundable fee is required.
- 17" and smaller, a \$20 non-refundable fee is required.

These non-refundable fee help cover costs incurred for processing, cleaning and repairing, including 3rd party fees we incur for pro-cessing and recycling unsold items.

We accept all small kitchen and household appliances that are in good working order.

-4ft x 4ft sheets or larger

Must be complete and free of nails and glue.
