ReStore Open Weekly, Tuesday thru Saturday

- **Shopping Only, from 10am to 5pm**
- **Donation drop-offs, from 10am to 2pm**
- Free donation pick-ups are available but we ask for your patience as the truck is very busy catching up with an overflow of requests. Expect delays. You can schedule a pick-up online at <https://www.lovelandhabitat.org/restore/>

Please remember

- Social distancing measures are in place and please limit your party to 2 people per cart.
- Customers are encouraged to wear safety masks.
- The fitting rooms and bathrooms are closed. No returns will be accepted.

We continue to evaluate ReStore operations in line with State and Local requirements. We appreciate your patience and support!

Our Construction site is open and our current schedule is:

- **Tuesday and Thursday- 3 volunteers per day**
- **Friday and Saturday- 10 volunteers per day**
- Masks are required, but we do not have them or any available, so please bring your own mask with you to the Habitat site.
- We encourage social distancing so please be mindful of your personal space.
- If you feel sick, do not come to the construction site.
