I hope this finds you and your loved ones healthy and safe. With the county's transition to Level Red, Safer at Home, we are making operational changes to ensure everyone's safety. Our goal is to serve the community as best possible during this difficult time and we greatly appreciate your patience and support. The following operational changes are effective immediately:

Loveland Habitat ReStore

- **Open Tuesday thru Saturday**
 - **Shopping Only, from 10am to 5pm**
 - **Donation drop-offs, from 10am to 2pm**
- **No more than 75 people allowed in the store...entry will be monitored**
- **Social distancing measures are in place**
- **No more than 2 people from one household per cart**
- **Safety masks are required to enter store**

- **The fitting rooms are closed and no returns will be accepted**
- **Volunteers and staff must submit to a wellness and health screening before being allowed to enter the store. If you feel sick, please stay at home.**
