I hope this finds you and your loved ones healthy and safe. With Larimer County being at Level Blue, we feel hopeful about moving toward a full reopening. The following operational changes are effective immediately:

Loveland Habitat ReStore

- **Open Tuesday - Saturday**
 - Shopping from 10am to 5pm
 - Donation drop-offs from 10am to 2pm
- **Starting June 1 - September 4, 2021**
 - Hours of Operation return to 10:00 am – 6:00 pm, Tuesday - Saturday
 - Donations drop-offs from 10am - 4pm
- **Our ReStore is at 75% of normal capacity**
- **Social distancing measures are in place**
- **Safety masks are required to enter store**

- **The fitting rooms are closed and no returns will be accepted**
