Dear Loveland Habitat for Humanity supporter,

A mask-wearing requirement for Colorado first went into effect in July 2020 and recently was amended in [Executive Order D 2021 103](#) on May 14, 2021. The amended Executive Order states that fully vaccinated people can go without masks in public indoor spaces unless the setting requires otherwise. Unvaccinated people over age 11 are encouraged to continue wearing masks in all public indoor spaces where members of different households are present.

The following operational changes are effective immediately:

- **Open Tuesday - Saturday**
 - Shopping from 10am to 5pm
 - Donation drop-offs from 10am to 2pm
- **Starting June 1 - September 4, 2021**
 - Hours of Operation return to 10:00 am – 6:00 pm, Tuesday - Saturday
 - Donations drop-offs from 10am - 4pm
- **Our ReStore is at 75% of normal capacity**
- **Social distancing measures are in place**

- **The fitting rooms are closed and no returns will be accepted**
