Roaring Fork PreCollegiate is a limited resources program that recruits highly motivated first generation students and helps them prepare for college. Regular and complete participation is essential for the successful completion of the PreCollegiate Program. Poor grades, absenteeism, and a lack of participation has a negative effect on staff, mentors and other students, and will negatively impact a student's readiness for college or career. The undersigned PreCollegiate Scholar acknowledges the philosophy and expectations of the PreCollegiate program and commits to the following:

1. I will attend all group mentor meetings, and it is my responsibility to determine when those meetings are occurring;
2. I will arrive on time at the commencement of any group meeting and will participate fully;
3. If I am tardy or am unable to attend a mentor meeting I will contact my mentor(s) or program staff in advance. I will be responsible for getting all missed assignments and making up any group work;
4. I will attend all required PreCollegiate events, including any test prep classes
5. I will attend all summer programs, which are held during the month of June;
5. While enrolled in PreCollegiate I will maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA, will follow all school rules, and will conduct myself as a responsible representative of my school and of PreCollegiate.

I understand that failing to meet these expectations may result in my removal from the PreCollegiate program.
